DELIVERY METOD SELECTION

Logo and icons, delivery time

To implement InPost International delivery in the checkout, simply follow two steps outlined in the following slides.

Present the InPost International service as shown below. Then, once the map for pickup point selection opens, the customer should choose a point located in the relevant country.

Step 1 Presentation of the delivery method selection in the shopping cart checkout.

1. Adjust the size and type of logo to fit the available space and display method on both mobile and desktop screens.

2. Use the local market name for the Paczkomat® (parcel locker) and PaczkoPunkt (pickup point) to avoid confusion. Online shoppers need to be certain about where and when they will collect their parcel.

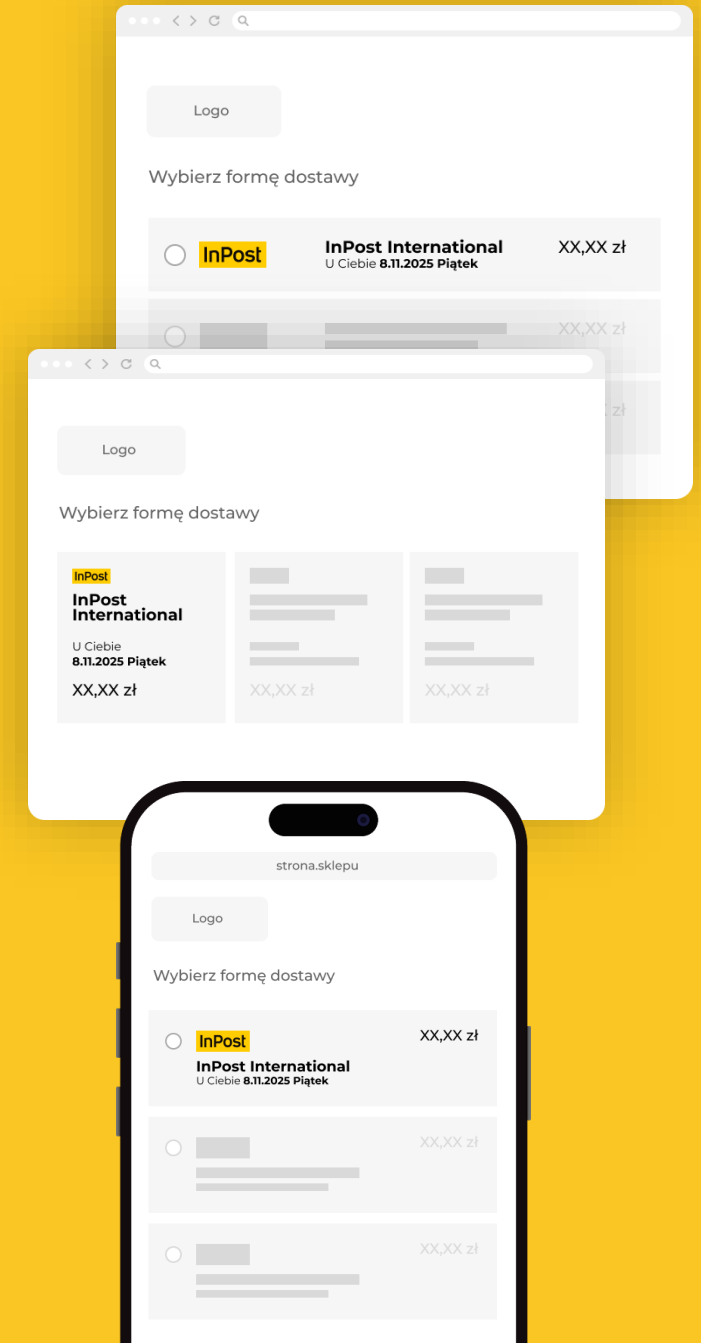
Specific names and recommendations by country can be found on pages 7–24.

3. Provide delivery time including preparation for shipment – for example, if the item is not in stock, indicate the time needed to prepare it. Example: Estimated delivery time: 3 business days; shipping from warehouse: 2 business days.

Indicate the expected delivery time by InPost. Transit time typically ranges from D+3 to D+5, depending on the destination country.

Acceptable formats:

- 3–5 business days
- 3 business days (France, Benelux, Hungary)
- 4 business days (Spain)
- 5 business days (Italy, islands, and Portugal)
- 2-3 business days (Austria)

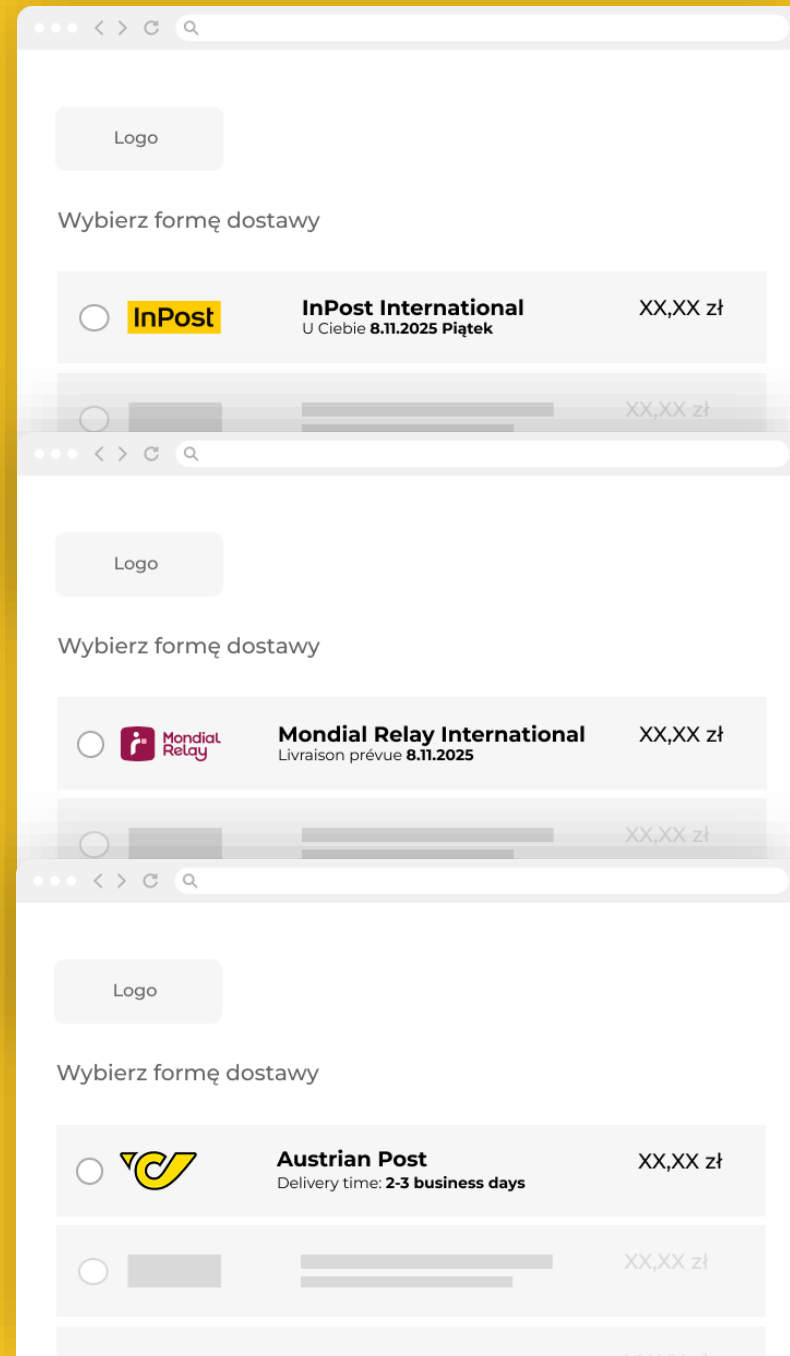

After selecting the delivery method in the previous step, the customer should be able to easily choose a pickup point from the map. Here, we describe how to best present this step to the customer.

Step 2 Pick-up point search

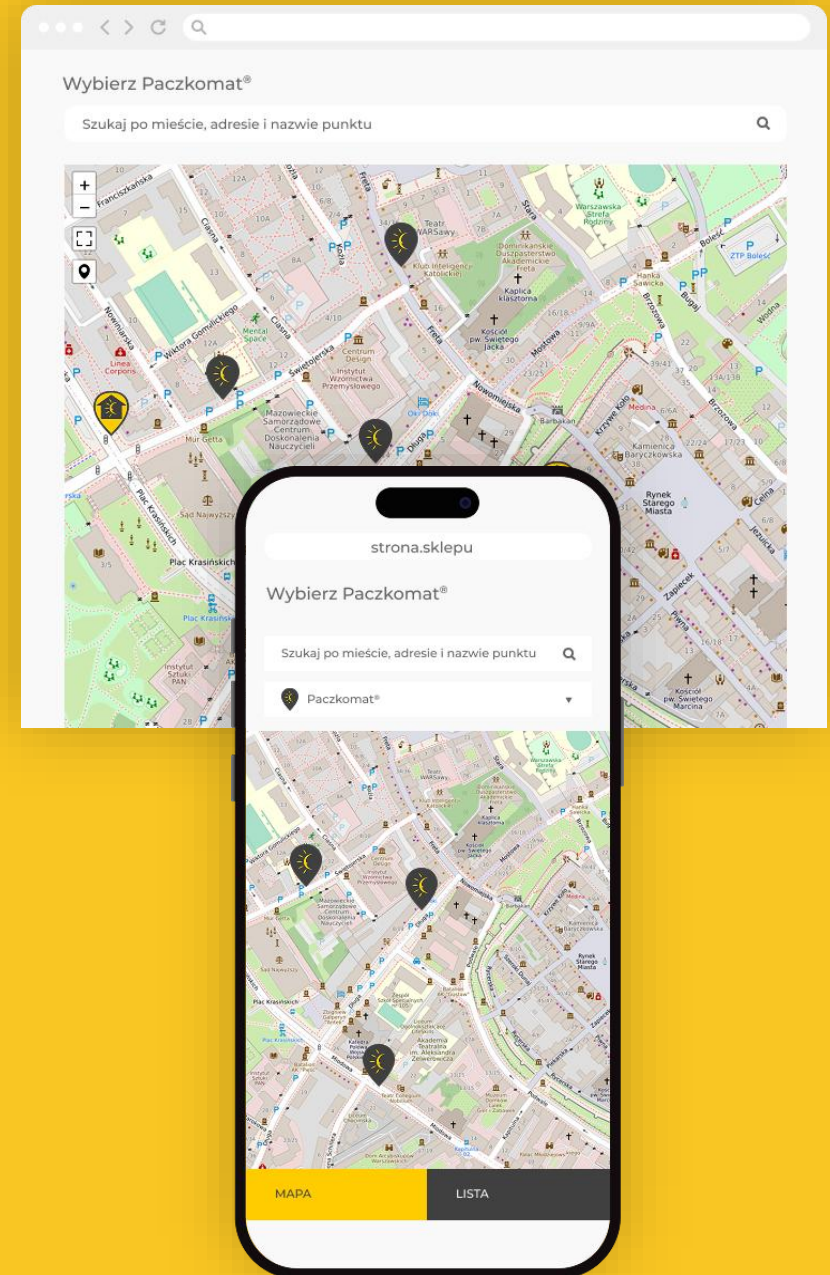
Map (geowidget) launch:

1. Since every Pickup Point and Paczkomat® (parcel locker) is displayed on the map and in the list, online shoppers can focus on one task – quickly finding their desired delivery location.
2. On mobile devices, the map should take up 100% of the screen, and in desktop browsers 90%, to make the selection process as user-friendly as possible.

For the following countries: France, Spain, Portugal, Belgium, Luxembourg, Italy, and the Netherlands The pick-up point map should display only the locations within the respective country (see visualisations on pages 8–24).

Geowidget set up:

1. After clicking the "Choose pickup point" button, the points in the selected country appear in the language set on the website. If Polish is set, the map will display in Polish by default.
2. The Geowidget allows filtering points by country – use the "country" field, e.g., => FR.

4. To configure the language of the Geowidget, use the "language" parameter. Available language settings: pl, en, uk, es, fr, pt, it

The map displays pick-up points located in the selected country.

Geowidget setup:

When the user clicks the "Choose pick-up point" button, the map shows locations in the relevant country, displayed in the language of the website. If the website language is set to Polish, the map will default to Polish.

The Geowidget allows filtering pick-up points by country — use the "country" field (e.g. FR)
